HOMEWORK POLICY

The Jones Hill SS Homework Policy is developed in consultation with the school community and endorsed by the P&C.

At JHSS, students receive weekly homework, which they are encouraged to complete with parent/carer supervision.

At Jones Hill State School the following time guidelines for homework apply:

Prep – Year 2 – up to 15 minutes per night Year 3 – 6 – up to 20 minutes per night

Homework should:

- Include reading for <u>All</u> students.
- ❖ Be of a level that students can mostly complete independently.
- Provided weekly and differentiated to allow for all students to complete tasks which are relevant to the curriculum.
- Encourage students to develop independence, responsibility and lifelong study habits.
- Be accessible to all students.
- ❖ Allow flexibility for family time, community, cultural and recreational activities.
- Be monitored by the class teacher.
- Encourage students to complete homework to the best of their ability.
- Be acknowledged for consistent completion.
- ❖ Parents/carers are encouraged to discuss homework with their child's teacher, especially if there are difficulties for their child or family.
- ❖ If parents request extension or extra homework for their child, the class teacher can recommend resources, Apps or online programs.
