Student Resource Scheme

Each year we offer the parents the opportunity to join the Student Resource Scheme. We have been running this scheme now for the past 4 years and have had the majority of parents participate. The scheme operates with the full support of the Jones Hill State School P&C.

This year we are offering parents and caregivers the chance to pay a single SRS payment that will include all stationery items, text books, art materials, printed material, cooking ingredients etc. Not only will we provide all the essential learning items your child will require, we will maintain them throughout the year. This means that you will not be required to purchase any items in the mentioned range for the entire year. There will be no booklists or notes home to parents asking for replacement items.

Everything previously on the booklist will supplied.

It will also enable us to purchase class sets of items like dictionaries and atlas', appropriate to each year level, that will be kept at school.

This scheme has been discussed with and fully endorsed by the Jones Hill State School P&C.

Can I opt out?

Those parents who do not wish their child to participate in the Student Resource Scheme will be given a booklist with all the required items listed.

Families who did not pay their resource scheme this year but participated, will not be eligible to join again until all fees are paid in full.

How will it work?

Students will arrive at school on day one and have everything that they require; therefore payment must be made before 24 January 2017. Payments may be made as a once off payment paid before 24 January 2017 or three negotiated instalments within the first week of terms 1, 2 and three.

It is anticipated that the cost of the resource will be \$120 per student. This cost is less than the book list and SRS fee. By purchasing in bulk we are better able to source far more competitive prices.

How do I join?

Please fill in the attached Student Resource Agreement Participation form and return to the school office on or before Friday November 11. Once your present your signed Participation form to the office and invoice will follow. The participation fee due for each nominated student is due and payable on your acceptance of the terms & conditions of the scheme ie. by ticking YES and signing of the Participation Agreement Form.

Payment of the participation agreement

Payment can be made by using EFTPOS, BPOINT, Direct Deposit, Cash or cheque. Alternatively a payment plan may be entered into following the completion of the **Payment Plan Participation Agreement.** This may include Centrelink Centrepay payments.
