Conditions of Entry

All entries must be the original work of entrants and must not have been published, or have won a prize in any literary competition prior to the closing date, Saturday 31 August 2019.

There are three age categories: Adult (18+ years) Teen (13-17 years) and Children (12 years and under).

A short story may be of any length up to a maximum 5000 words in the adult and teen sections, and a maximum of 3000 words in the children's section.

A poem may be of any length up to a maximum of 200 lines in the adult and teen sections, and a maximum of 100 lines in the children's section.

Entries MUST be clear and easy to read and should be:

- typed on white A4 paper
- typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, left justified
- stapled in top left-hand corner
- without illustrations
- with each page titled and numbered.

Short stories should have double line spacing with 3-4cm margins.

Poems should have single line spacing with double line spacing between verses.

Limit of one entry per person in each section.

Copyright remains with the author.

Entrants are advised to keep copies of their work as entries will not be returned.

Name of entrant must not appear on the work, only on the entry form.

Entries may be reproduced for local media and library promotional purposes.

Entrants may have their photo taken and used for library promotional purposes.

Prize winners' names and details will be supplied to Bendigo Bank for the purpose of writing prize winners' cheques.

Winners will be announced at the Gympie Region Literary Awards event at Gympie Library on Friday 25 October 2019.

Names of winners will be published in the local press and on the Gympie Regional Libraries website and Facebook pages.

Gympie Regional Libraries reserve the right to display the works for two weeks after the event.

No late entries will be accepted.







Gympie Regional Libraries will be conducting the annual Gympie Region Literary Awards in October 2019.

One of the aims of this literary competition is to expose the many hidden talents of people in the Gympie region and surrounding area which may otherwise go unrecognised, and to encourage the writing talents of all who choose to participate.

The competitions are open to all who reside in the Gympie Regional Council area and surrounding council regions. Entrants are free to choose the topic or subject matter they wish to write about.
