

# Do you need assistance to join the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)?

The Assessment and Referral Team (ART) provides free assistance to eligible Queenslanders needing help with their NDIS application.

## How can ART assist you?

ART can help you to:

- Fill in your NDIS application form
- Identify existing evidence of disability
- Gather the relevant supporting documents from your doctor or specialist
- Connect with clinicians for diagnosis where required

## Who is eligible for ART assistance?

To qualify for assistance, you must be:

- Between the ages of 7 and 65
- An Australian resident living within an identified ART delivery region in Queensland
- Needing supports as a result of a permanent and significant disability.

The following groups are encouraged to seek assistance:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- People from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- People who live in rural, remote and regional areas
- Children attending a special school
- School leavers
- Children or young people in youth detention
- Adults subject to supervision by Community Corrections
- Prisoners leaving the criminal justice system.
