Vacation Care Terms and Conditions

<u>Fees</u>

- I am aware Vacation Care is only for prep to year 6 students and operates from 6:30am 6:00pm during the dates advised above.
- I must sign my child in and out each day as it is a legal obligation.
- Fees are detailed and incursions/excursions fees will be advised in advance.

Accounts

• Please note that every child must be fully enrolled, have approved CCS and bank details entered, *before* they can attend Koala Kids Vacation Care.

Behaviour

• For the safety and wellbeing of others, inappropriate behaviour will be managed in accordance with our Behaviour management Policy. This is available for your perusal at the sign in desk.

<u>Lunches and Snacks</u>

- Breakfast, morning tea and afternoon tea are provided. Breakfast is only provided to those who arrive before 7:30am.
- All dietary needs are required to be advised on enrolment.
- A healthy lunch is required each day the child attends. Due to health regulations, we are not able to heat food brought from home.

Daily Requirements

- Children need to bring the following each day; broad brimmed hat, water bottle, sunscreen and lunch.
- Closed in shoes need to be worn every day. Children need them to play sport and to wear to the bathroom (no bare feet in toilets). Children can bring thongs on wet play days to wear while playing in the water activities.
- It is suggested that children bring a spare set of clothes in their bags, particularly on wet play and messy days.
- Toys, phones, electronic devices are NOT ALLOWED.

Quiet Time

• Children will have quiet time in the middle of the day. In this time, children may watch a movie, read books or rest. Children should bring a pillow/cushion and sheet to rest on. These items must be named and may be left at the service for the duration of vacation care.

Bookings & Cancellations

• Bookings must be received via the booking form attached. I understand that I must cancel my child by 9am, three days prior to the booked session. Full fees will be charged for any cancelations other than this.

Enrolling

• If you are not enrolled in our service yet, please contact our staff on the numbers below to receive an electronic link to start the process of enrolment.

The program does not show all planned activities – we often do many things on a day to day basis and use suggestions from the children.
